THE PROBLEM WE'RE FIXING



Over 50% of the working population have **missed a day** of work due to home-life stressors, including; demands from children's schedules & caring for family members.



Research by the Australian Institute of Family Studies (AIFS) notes that this rise is in part due to the need for **two incomes to meet cost-of-living** and housing pressures.



In 2025, the Australian Bureau of Statistics found that **73% of families with children aged 0-14yrs had both parents employed**. Risen 13% since 2005.



The AIFS points to employment and work demands alongside family responsibilities presenting **major** challenges for modern families.

Though not strictly ABS data, complementary evidence shows parents are able to report only little leisure time and feeling "time-poor",



"Role overload" - where individuals feel there are simply **not enough hours or energy to meet demands**, work, family, and personal expectations. The demands of daily life means secondary roles (household demands) must be done in *leisure-time*, leading to lesser time for rest, personal development, exercise and leisure time.

Villey offers a variety of employee benefits tailored to support different life stages and career needs:

- Supporting new parents by providing household and childminding assistance during the early stages of parenthood.
- Assisting parents in smoothly transitioning back to work after maternity or paternity leave.
- Empowering female employees to advance in their careers and attain senior leadership roles with the assistance of Villey helpers.
- Offering redundant employees or those planning for retirement another work opportunity to stay engaged and earn additional income as a Villey helper.
- Enabling mothers to pursue full-time employment opportunities instead of parttime roles with the assistance of a Villey helper.

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Community Commitment

Villey is more than just an app; it's a supportive community where individuals thrive together. By partnering with Villey, organisations can demonstrate a genuine commitment to the holistic health and wellbeing of its employees and team members.

Villey is accessible Australia-wide. All users have access to an online Support Chat to guide and assist with operating the app and connecting with local helpers.

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Tax Deductible Offering

By providing Villey as an employee wellness or family support initiative, Australia companies can claim the expense as am end oif year tax deduction.

How it works:

- Partnering companies are invoiced for the amount they wish to gift a certain employee or group of individual employees.
- Once the company invoice is paid, a unique code is then generated for the user and issued to the company to distribute.
- The employee(s) is/are encouraged to download the Villey app, create a client account and add their unique voucher number to add 'credit' to their account balance.
- When engaging with a helper for domestic services or casual childminding, the employees's credit balance will be deducted accordingly, at the conclusion of the service as a form of payment.
